## TRANSITION AGREEMENT

Emily Carr Institute of Art and Design, Industrial Design program prepares students to be skilled and talented interpreters of technology and human needs, to give products personality, to humanize the domestic landscape, and to respect the larger social and environmental responsibilities of design.

The Industrial Design program has recently expanded to include a range of courses that focus directly on innovative wood product development. These courses include institutional collaborations with UBC for *Wood Science* and BCIT for *Wood Techniques and Technologies*.

Students graduate from Emily Carr with a Bachelor of Design Degree and are recruited by industry within Canada and internationally.

Enrollment is limited to 30 seats per year. Students are accepted to the Industrial Design program based on a portfolio interview. Following acceptance, students may receive credit for their previous experiences through 'prior learning assessment'.
