



TRANSITION AGREEMENT

The University College of the Cariboo has a new two-year program in Wood Process Technology, providing education and hands-on skill building experiences, which will enable graduates to contribute to efficient, cost-effective processing of BC wood products.

Graduates have an excellent future as the forest industry moves toward value-added manufacturing of wood products, with job opportunities in the growing private sector manufacturing industry. Graduates of the Wood Process Technology program work as technicians, technologists, managers and inspectors in secondary wood manufacturing operations.

Value-added wood manufacturers in BC support this program, and have participated in curriculum development. Primary wood manufacturers in BC have also indicated an interest in the development of this program and the eventual hiring of its graduates.

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WoodLINKS Advance Credit

The Science 11 requirement will be waived for those students who have completed the WoodLINKS courses in Secondary School. Students should indicate that they have completed the WoodLINKS program on their application form by responding "yes" to the Career Prep question, and writing WoodLINKS in the space provided. Students who have not completed the WoodLINKS program must provide proof of Physic 11, Chemistry 11, or Biology 11. In addition, Math 11 is required for entry in to the second year of the program. Instruction to the Math 11 level is available. Students may complete the Math requirements while in the first year of the program or through summer study between the first and second year.
