Certification Process

Certification Elements

WoodLINKS certification is currently awarded at 2 levels: Introduction and Advanced. Both levels are required for full certification.

Students who apply for WoodLINKS certification are required to:

1. **Write the WoodLINKS certification exam for each level**
 - A multiple-choice exam set and managed by WoodLINKS.
2. **Be evaluated by a WoodLINKS Teacher**
 - Evaluation tools used are at the teacher's discretion
3. **Undergo a Partnership Evaluation for each level**
 - Each student must complete the WoodLINKS Practical Skills CheckLIST, and have it signed off by the instructor.

Certification Grading

Student performance on the WoodLINKS certification examination is equal to 40% of the certification score.

The WoodLINKS teacher's evaluation of student in-class performance is equal to 60% of the certification score.

Student completion of the Practical Skills CheckLIST is mandatory to qualify for certification.

To be awarded certification, a student must score a combined grade of at least 70% from the certification exam and the teacher evaluation, for each level (Introduction or Advanced). Full certification requires completion of both Introduction and Advanced Wood Products Manufacturing.

Annual Fees
